

305: St George Academy Faculty and staff Attire

St. George Academy is an institution of academic excellence and thought. All faculty and staff are expected to dress intentionally professional and support the educational environment when on campus. SGA requires a modern business casual standard for all faculty members during instruction, faculty trainings and meetings with parents.

Expectations of Modern Business Casual

- Attire is sufficiently above the student style and promotes appropriate student/teacher boundaries
- Attire and self are clean and well-groomed
- Attire must cover undergarments and the trunk of the body at all times
- Skirts or dresses reach the knee when standing
- Jeans must be elevated with stylish accessories, vest, or blazer
- Casual tops must be elevated with stylish accessories, vest, or blazer
- Reasonable specialty attire is suitable for scheduled classroom activities, PE, science labs, art, etc.
- Attire must be free of depictions or language that violate Utah Educator Professional Standards

Attire that does not fit the Modern Business Casual Definition

Dressing professionally sends a positive message of self-worth to our students as we teach them skills that promote future success. Dress standard questions can be resolved with self-reflection: if you are in doubt, dress above the standard not below. The following items and styles are deemed too casual for faculty during instructional responsibilities, faculty trainings and meetings with parents:

- Shorts
- Tank tops (garment that hugs the body, was intended to be under clothes, or has straps less than three fingers wide)
- Flip flops
- Jeans and T-shirt combo
- Track suits, sweats or athletic stretch pants
- Rips or tears in a garment

Faculty and staff who violate SGA attire expectations will be subject to the SGA disciplinary procedure.
