

# 602: Dual Enrollment Policy

## 1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to state St. George Academy's position on the dual enrollment of private school and home-schooled students at SGA. St. George Academy is an active supporter of educational choice in our community and supports alternative approaches to education. St. George Academy must comply with all rules governing dual enrollment presented in state statute (e.g. [UAC R277-438](#)) and other rules of the Utah Office of Education.

## 2. Policy

2.1 A student who is exempt from compulsory public school education by a local school board for instruction in a private or home school may enroll in at St. George Academy as a dual enrollment student and participate in one or more courses, co-curricular activity, or program.

2.2 A dual enrollment student attending an activity or a portion of a school day under Section 53A-11-102.5 is subject to the same behavior and discipline rights and requirements of a full-time student.

2.3 A dual enrollment student who attends an activity or a portion of the school day is subject to the administrative scheduling and faculty discretion of SGA.

2.4 A dual enrollment student with a disability may participate as a dual enrollment student consistent with law, this rule and 34 CFR 300.450 through 300.455.

2.5 If requested, St. George Academy will prepare an IEP for a student described in Subsection (3)(a) prior to the student's participation in dual enrollment using comparable procedures to those required for identifying and evaluating public school students.

2.6. A student with a disability seeking dual enrollment is entitled to services for the time, or for the number of courses, the student is enrolled in St. George Academy based on the decision of the student's IEP team.

2.7 Dual enrolled students will pay all required fees for their enrollment in courses and/or associated with extra-curricular activities. St. George Academy shall waive a student participation fee for a dual enrollment private or home school student if the student is eligible for fee waiver and the parent provides the required documentation,

2.8 Requests for dual enrollment should be provided to the SGA Administration at the time of student registration
