

606: Online Credit Policy

1. Purpose:

St. George Academy believes that a variety of learning options, including online courses and programs, are critical for today's learners. SGA recognizes that the online learning environment provides students with unique opportunities to become self-disciplined learners with life-long learning skills. Therefore, the school supports a range of online learning opportunities that are equally accessible to all students requiring or desiring supplemental learning opportunities.

2. Policy:

St. George Academy will facilitate a variety of online learning opportunities to its students. Online courses accepted for credit must be determined appropriate by all SGA stakeholders. No part of this policy or the procedures associated with it will supersede the law as it relates to Special Education.

3. Procedure:

3.1. Any online learning course for which original or recovery credit is awarded must be approved by the Administration in advance of the student's enrollment in the course.

3.2. Approval to award credit for online courses must be requested by the student, parents and representative faculty member if applicable.

3.3. Student Services will review applications requesting approval to award credit for online courses.

3.4. Applications requesting approval to award credit for online courses must be submitted as soon as necessary for the course becomes recognized.

3.5. Authorization to grant credit must be obtained in writing from the Administration prior to student enrollment in the online course.
